

Day 1- Depart from Sweden

Flight from Göteborg or Stockholm to Delhi by Finnair.

Day 2 - Arrive Delhi

Arrive Delhi 6:30 by Finnair and transfer to hotel The Uppal.

After lunch city tour to New Delhi.

New Delhi - stands in formal splendor. It is a city of wide boulevards which offers ever changing perspectives of Lutyen's landscaped city. It is a city rich with formal parks, Parliament Building and the Rashtrapati Bhawan (the official residence of the President of India in the 330 acres of land designed by Sir Edwin Lutyens), once the awe-inspiring residence of the British Viceroy, India Gate (a majestic 42 mts high arch, built as a memorial to the Indian Soldiers killed in World War I), visit to Dilli Haat & shopping mall.

Day 3 - Delhi / Nagpur / Pench

Early morning transfer to airport in time for flight to Nagpur by 6E 135 depart at 08:55. Arrive Nagpur 10:30 hrs, straight drive to Pench national park.

Transfer to Pench Jungle Camp.

Evening game drive in Pench national park.

Pench Wildlife National Park: The park is situated in the Seoni district of southern Madhya Pradesh and runs in continuation with Pench National Park of Maharashtra. The Pench Wildlife Sanctuary was named after the river Pench that flows nearby. The place was declared as a notified area in 1972 and as the Wildlife Sanctuary in 1983. The park is the 19th Tiger Reserve in the country and has quite a few tigers and other wildlife population. The park is home to a large number of endangered species. The park has high density of the Chital, Four Horned Antelopes, Gaur, Muntjac, Nilgai and Wild pig. The park has a huge population bird life as well. The census of the bird population in the park is more than 125 species like Barbets, Blue Kingfishers, Bulbuls, Minivets, Munias, Mynas, Orioles, Wagtails and Waterfowls. The Pench River and the Water Streams provide a place to the water birds of this region.

Day 4 - Pench

Morning & Evening game drive at Pench national park.

Day 5 - Pench / Kanha

Early morning after breakfast drive to Kanha and transfer to hotel The Baagh.

Lunch at Kanha and evening game drive at Kanha national park.

Kanha National Park : It is one of the largest national parks covering 1945 sq. km including a 'core zone' of 940 sq km. It is also part of Project Tiger, one of India's most important conservation forts. The setting for Kipling's jungle book, we will travel by jeep and elephant (for tiger viewing), through different habitats, including Sal Forest, Bamboo Thicket, Dadar (plateau grasslands), meadows and Mixed Forests. This beautiful area of forest and lightly wooded grassland with many rivers and streams supports an excellent variety of wildlife. Some of the species we may encounter include the endangered Hard-ground Barasingha (this being the only place where this sub species remains), Barking Deer, Spotted Deer, the largest bovine Gaur, Golden-backed Jackal, Jungle Cat, Common Langur, Sloth Bear, Wild Boar, and Wild Dog and the elusive Chausingha and the tiger.

Overnight at hotel The Baagh.

Day 6 - Kanha

Morning & Evening game drive at Kanha national park.

Overnight at The Baagh.

Day 7 - Kanha

Morning games drive at Kanha national park.

Evening village walk.

Overnight at The Baagh.

Day 8 - Kanha / Bandhavgarh

After breakfast leave Kanha drive to Bandhavgarh and transfer to hotel Nature Heritage.

Overnight at Nature Heritage.

Day 9 - Bandhavgarh

Morning & Evening game drive at Bandhavgarh National park.

BANDHAVGARH : Bandhavgarh is known for one of the densest populations of Tigers in India and was included in Project Tiger in 1994. The forests are dominated by Sal and Bamboo, good for species such as white-napped Woodpecker, Red jungle fowl, Red and painted spur fowl. The habitat is enriched by riverine forest, open grasslands and marshy areas where lesser adjutants survive in small numbers. The steep cliffs of Bandhavgarh Hill surmounted by the 2000 year old fort provide nesting habitat for long billed vultures, House Swifts and the resident race of peregrine Falcon known as Shahin. At night Mottled Wood owl and Brown Fish Owl hunt for prey. Most northern migrants see present during winter, but April and May see the arrival of interesting species such as cuckoos and India Pitta from the South. There are some 250 species on the sanctuary's list.

Day 12 - Bandhavgarh / Khajuraho

After breakfast drive to Khajuraho and transfer to hotel Clarks Khajuraho.

Evening temple visit to Temples.

KHAJURAHO : The city was once the original capital of the Chandela Rajputs a Hindu dynasty that ruled this part of India from the 10th to the 12th centuries. The Khajuraho temples were built over a span of a hundred years, from 950 to 1050. The Chandela capital was moved to Mahoba after this time, but Khajuraho continued to flourish for some time. The whole area was enclosed by a wall with eight gates, each flanked by two golden palm trees. There were originally over 80 Hindu temples, of which only 22 now stand in a reasonable state of preservation, scattered over an area of about 8 square miles. The Khajuraho temples, constructed with spiral superstructures, adhere to a northern Indian shikhara temple style and often to a Panchayatana plan or layout. A few of the temples are dedicated to the Jain pantheon and the rest to Hindu deities - to God's Trio, Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva, and various Devi forms, such as the Devi Jagadamba temple.

Day 13 - Khajuraho /Delhi

After lunch transfer to airport in time for flight to Delhi by 9W 724 depart at 1330 hrs. Arrive Delhi at 1600 hrs and transfer to hotel The Uppal.

Overnight at hotel The Uppal.

Day 14 - Delhi / Sweden

Early morning transfer to International airport in time for flight to Sweden by Finnair.
