ITINERARY....

19 FEB'27 / FRI **ARRIVE DELHI** **(B, L & D)**

On your arrival at international airport in Delhi and after clearing customs & immigration, our representative will greet you and transfer to the hotel (Check in time 1400 hrs).

Delhi, the capital of kingdoms and empires is now a sprawling metropolis with a fascinating blend of the past and the present. It is a perfect introduction to the composite culture of an ancient land.

Half day sightseeing of Old Delhi along with Rickshaw ride.

Stay overnight at Delhi.

20 FEB'27 / SAT **DELHI –JABALPUR – BANDHAVGARH** **(B, L & D)**

After breakfast transfer to airport to board the flight to Jabalpur.

SG 2871 (Spice Jet) **Delhi/Jabalpur** **1010/1200 hrs**

Upon arrival at Jabalpur airport, drive to Bandhavgarh (200Kms / 3-4 hrs).

Bandhavgarh National Park: Set amongst The Vindhya Hills in Madhya Pradesh, Bandhavgarh consists of 168 sq miles of Sal & a mixed forest of bamboo, grassland, and a complex of deciduous forests. There



are at least 150 species of birds in the park, along with other mammals such as Tigers, Sloth Bear, Langur Monkeys, Wild Boar, Mongoose, 3 Kinds Of Deer - Chital, Sambar And Barking, to name a few.

Stay overnight at Bandhavgarh.

Note: All national parks in Madhya Pradesh shall remain closed to the visitors for afternoon safaris on all Wednesdays.

21 to 23 FEB'27 / SUN to TUE BANDHAVGARH (B, L & D)

Early morning wake-up call with a knock on your room door and Tea/Coffee.

You will wake up to misty mornings and sounds of birds calling, which will make an exciting start to your day. As soon as dawn breaks, leave for your Jungle Safari, accompanied by a resident naturalist and forest park guides in 4x 4 Jeeps.

In the winter months morning safaris require warm clothes and woolen caps and gloves to keep you warm



from the wind chill factor in your open jeep. We provide blankets and sometimes even a hot water bottle to keep you comfortable.

Lunch and afternoon safari by 4x4 jeep accompanied by resident naturalist and forest guide. Return to lodge for evening tea and rest of time free to relax.

Stay overnight at Bandhavgarh.

24 FEB'27 / WED BANDHAVGARH – KANHA (B, L & D)

After morning safari drive to Kanha national Park (**5-6 hrs drive**). The drive will take us through rural countryside, colorful town & villages.

Upon arrival at Kanha, check in at Kanha Jungle Lodge.

Kanha National Park-Set on The Chhota Nagpur Plateau in Madhya Pradesh, Kanha provides breath



taking vistas of grassy plains and strands sal forests. This 366 sq mile preserve was set to save two endangered species i.e. Tiger and The Barasingha. The park offers a variety of species including Tigers and Leopards, Cheetal, Gaur, Barking Deer, Sambhar Deer and the endangered Barasingha Deer.

Stay overnight in Kanha.

25 to 27 FEB'27 / THU to SAT

KANHA

(B, L & D)

Early morning wake-up call with a knock on your room door and Tea/Coffee.

You will wake up to misty mornings and sounds of birds calling, which will make an exciting start to your day. As soon as dawn breaks, leave for your Jungle Safari, accompanied by a resident naturalist and forest park guides in 4x 4 Jeeps.

A picnic breakfast in the middle of the Jungle with a cup of hot Tea or Coffee.

Rest of the morning at leisure or go for nature walk, visit to nearby village/school or engage yourself in cooking demonstration.

Lunch and afternoon safari by 4x4 open jeep.

Return to lodge for evening tea and rest of time free for star gazing.

Stay overnight at Kanha.

Note: All national parks in Madhya Pradesh shall remain closed to the visitors for afternoon safaris on all Wednesdays (02nd March is Wednesday).

After breakfast, drive to Satpura (8 hrs drive).

Satpura National Park is located in south Hoshangabad district in Madhya Pradesh. The 524 Sqkm Park



is the core area of the Panchmarchi Biosphere Reserve that includes Bori wildlife sanctuary to its south-west and Panchmarhi wildlife sanctuary to its north-east. The park has an elevation of 320-1,352m with tall sandstone mountains, narrow gorges, ravines, waterfalls, streams and dense forests near the Mahadev hills in the Pachmarhi plateau. The area boasts of two unique species of tree – the sal and the teak besides wide varieties of ferns, mango trees, butterflies and birds.

Upon arrival at Satpura, check into the lodge.

Stay overnight at Bori Safari Lodge.

The Bori Safari Lodge is a perfect base to explore the unchartered Bori Wildlife Sanctuary. The Bori



Wildlife Sanctuary along with Satpura National Park and Pachmarhi Sanctuary comprise the Satpura Tiger Reserve, forming a 2,200 sq kilometre contiguous stretch of forest teeming with classic Central Indian Wildlife like, Sloth Bear, Leopard, Wild Dog, Tiger, Gaur, Giant Squirrel and other mammal and bird life. Bori Safari Lodge is located on a farmland estate neighbouring Dhapadamal village and is well located close to the park entry gate of the sanctuary. The lodge provides an immersive experience for a variety of travellers. Whether the priority is to explore the sanctuary for its wildlife or engage in a Central Indian rural experience. Game drives, walking safaris, night drive, bird watching and anthropological walks to name a few are engaging activities that can be done while staying at the lodge. Our expert naturalists are well versed with the landscape and are ever ready to bring the experience alive for you. The 8 well-appointed contemporary rooms have private viewing decks overlooking green fields that attract several open country bird species. The central courtyard is the place for recreation and socializing, with the dining, lounge and library embedded in its interestingly decided structure. There is an outdoor dining and viewing space with a good view of the infinity pool and an open to the sky private dining seating. The cuisine is mouth-watering, with the classic Jehan Numa touch. The emphasis on ingredients is local, a lot of which is grown within the lodge grounds. We practice organic farming laying emphasis on crop rotation and companion plantation. Biological pest control and mix cropping is encouraged, this adds to the freshness in all the food that is cooked in our kitchen. We are also inspired by the local cuisines and sometimes invite our village neighbors to come and cook for us and our guests. The Bori Safari Lodge is a perfect place for discerning travelers who are looking for an immersive nature-based eco-tourism experience in Central India. It is also a great place for families and all our experiences are child friendly.



Morning & Afternoon jeep safari on exclusive basis in a 4x4 safari vehicle (This is the best way to explore large areas looking for wildlife).

Note: National park in Madhya Pradesh (Central India) will remain closed on Wednesday. However, alternatively we can organize various activities at the lodges like nature walk/bird watching in and around the lodge or a village safari.

Stay overnight in Bori Safari Lodge.

02 MAR'27 / TUE BORI SAFARI LODGE - RENI PANI JUNGLE LODGE (B, L & D)

Morning safari by jeep and explore the core area of park. Lunch at rest house, inside the national park and transfer to Reni Pani Jungle lodge through park.



We have taken two safaris with combination of two different park gates to reach Bori safari Lodge without missing any safari experience. We have taken one morning safari from Bori Safari Lodge and second safari to Reni Pani Jungle Lodge gate. Your luggage will be transfer by separate vehicle to Reni pani lodge.

Stay overnight at Reni Pani Jungle Lodge.

Reni Pani Jungle Lodge, located in a pristine forest typical of the Satpura Tiger Reserve, gets its interesting name from a neighboring tribal village. Reni Pani features twelve luxury cottages encompassing three distinct architectural designs. The nallah units, the forest units and the hill units are all built using local / indigenous material and are characterized by viewing decks, large lounging bay-windows and luxury bathrooms. The 'GolGhar' or the meeting place, has a fascinating and unique design and features a dining area, a bar, a library and a lounge set in its various corners. Reni Pani's seasonal nallah, stretch of teak, rugged hillocks and gauges are an accurate representation of terrain one should expect in the Satpura Tiger Reserve. Its true forest environment coupled with neighbouring patches of agricultural land make Reni Pani and its surrounding areas a hot bed for animals like Sambhar, Cheetal,



Nilgai, Wild Boar, Barking Deer, Black Buck and occasionally for their cunning predator the Leopard. The abundance of Reni Trees (a type of berry after which the lodge and village are named after) and other berry trees, also attract a number of Sloth Bears to Reni Pani. The lodge is also rich with bird life. The ideal conditions Reni Pani offers as a result of the maintenance of a completely natural habitat, attracts several bird species that are native to the locality.

03 MAR'27 / WED

RENI PANI JUNGLE LODGE

(B, L & D)

Indulge yourself with morning and afternoon Jeep Safari/ walking safari / Boat Safari/ bush walk around the camp or village walk.

Jeep Safaris: This is the best way to explore large areas looking for wildlife.

Boat Safaris: The Park offers exploring the areas along the river by using boats. Again one has the option of using either a canoe or a motor boat. Boat safaris are excellent if one wants to get close to aquatic birds or sometimes even crocodiles.

Walking Safari: Exploring the forest on foot too is an interesting experience especially if you have a highly skilled naturalist that could really bring alive the lesser fauna such as geckos, butterflies, frogs and birds that one sometimes misses during other safaris.

Stay overnight at Reni Pani Jungle Lodge.

04 MAR'27 / THU

SATPURA – BHOPAL - DELHI

(B, L & D)



After morning safari, drive to Nagpur airport to board the flight to Nagpur.

Upon arrival in Delhi, check in to hotel.

Stay overnight in Delhi.
